In the junior division (ages 9–12), champion was awarded to Nolan Chalmers of Shanty Bay, ON and reserve went to Abby Falconer from Pictou, Nova Scotia.

In the intermediate division (ages 13–16), champion went to Hillary Sauder from Hodgeville, SK and Riley Leeson from Vauxhall, AB received reserve champion.

Albertans ruled the senior division (age 17–21), with Becky Domolewski of Taber selected as champion and Gus Dietrich from Forestburg chosen as reserve champion.

Youth participating in the Literature Competition compose a poem, essay, story or other type of literature with an agriculture theme and submit it for judging at Showdown. Entries are judged based on their use of proper grammar, creativity, and quality of writing. This year's competition was judged by long-time Maritime Angus Association Secretary Betty Lou Scott.

The Canadian Junior Angus Association is a group of Angus enthusiasts under the age of 21. Showdown is an annual summer cattle show organized by the Canadian Junior Angus Association. It rotates to provinces throughout the country every July. This year there were 72 participants that took part in Showdown in Truro, NS.
