Canadian Junior Angus Association Showdown Team Judging Competition Winners Selected by Judge Kristine Sauter

ROCKY VIEW COUNTY, AB — The Canadian Junior Angus Association is pleased to announce the winners of the Team Judging Competition for Showdown 2014. Awards were presented at the Showdown banquet on July 19th.

To compete in this event, participants had to place in the top six placing for their age division after the Card Judging Competition was over. The top six were then randomly placed on teams and competed in team judging. Team judging competitors are evaluated on their ability to judge a class of bred heifers. During the competition, the acting judge is judged on their placing of the class as well as their ability to present reasons over the microphone. The ring person is judged on their ability to keep the cattle organized and in good order in the ring.

The champion team in the junior division (ages 9–12) was won by Baxter Blair and Hillary Sauder and the reserve champions were Laura Glover and Taron Topham.

In the intermediate division (ages 13–16) the champion team was Naomi Best and Mikayla Blaschuck. Taylor Carvey and Cheyenne Catley were the reserve champion team.

Champions in the senior division (ages 17–21) were Chad Lorenz and Nicholas Bray and the reserve champion team was Michaela Chalmers and Shane Roger.

The Canadian Junior Angus Association is a group of Angus enthusiasts under the age of 21. Showdown is an annual summer cattle show organized by the Canadian Junior Angus Association. It rotates to provinces throughout the country every July. This year there were 92 participants that took part in Showdown in Virden, Manitoba.
